How does WNAP work?



WNAP connects warriors and their families with the resources to navigate the health care system. This helps them return to productive, engaged lives. Our WNAP team works with individuals and their families who may have had difficulties accessing necessary sources of support.

We also help participants and their families understand the paths available in the military health care systems; as well as resources from community-based programs and the civilian health care sector.

What does WNAP offer?

Case Management

An assigned case manager works directly with the recovering warriors and their families until they no longer need assistance.

Health Care Navigator

Dedicated, specially trained associates assist recovering warriors and their families with non-clinical needs. They evaluate and determine the guidance or direction to resolve the issue at hand.
